

Sound Blends Articulation Worksheets (Except /r/ Blends, Those are in the /r/ Pack)

What's Included:

• Practice sheets for using various sound blends in words.

How to Use Them:

Choose the sound blend that is easiest for the child and have the child say the words on the worksheet after you. Once he is able to do that consistently, point to each picture and ask "what's this?" an have him say the words on his own. Then, do the same with the other worksheets in this pack.

Once the child can say all of the words on the worksheets, have the child say the words in phrases (like "my ____" or "I see ____". Then, once he's mastered that, he can move onto saying the words in full sentences that he makes up. Just ask him to use each word in a sentence.

The Next Step:

Once the child is able to produce the sound easily in sentences, you can start working on the sound in structured conversation.



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
