How to Print:

I highly recommend printing these on carbon copy papers so you can have a backup copy to save for your files, though this is optional. Then, simply cut each sheet in half and it makes two handouts that you can use!

How to Use:

At the end of each session, simply check the boxes that indicate what you worked on during that session. You can write notes about how well the child did or about which specific examples of that skill you worked on (ex: writing “foods” under vocabulary to indicate you worked on food words). You can even take your data directly on this form and send it home to the parent so they know exactly how their child is doing. Plus, then you have a handy data sheet to stick in your file (the carbon copy).
