## **General Checklist**

**Instructions:** The following is a list of red flags that may indicate that a child has communication concerns that need to be checked out by a speech-language pathologist. Check the box next to any of the following red flags that the child seems to have. The more boxes checked, the more likely there is a problem that should be addressed by a speech-language pathologist.
