

Blank Visual Schedule

Instructions:


Use this blank visual schedule to help children understand what's coming next and what they will get when they complete their work.

- 1. Print out the page and put it in a plastic sheet protector.
- 2. With a dry erase marker, write the tasks that the child needs to do, one in each box. You can also draw pictures of the tasks if the child isn't reading well yet.
- 3. At the bottom of the board, write or draw two options of things that the child can do when he's finished.
- 4. As the child completes the tasks, have him erase them or cross them out to indicate that they are done.
- 5. When the child has completed all tasks, have him chose one reward from the bottom of the page.



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
