



Visual Aids for Retelling a Narrative Story

Introduction:

This story board will help a child remember the events to a narrative that he has recently heard so that he can retell the story with all of the correct elements.

Instructions:

Read a story aloud to the child. Then, have the child help fill out the worksheet on the next page by drawing, writing, or telling you what to write in each box. Talk through all of the story elements presented on the next page.

Once the page is completed, have the child retell the story by including all of the elements from the page.



How to Retell a Story

Instructions: Use this page to help the child retell a story that he/she just heard. Draw or write your answers to each section in the box. Then, string it all together to retell the story. Put this page in a sheet protector and use a dry erase marker to fill out each section so that you can use it again!

Setting: Where does the story take place? When does it take place?



Characters: Who is in the story?



Events: What happens in the story?



Problem: What was the problem in the story?



Solution: What did the characters do to fix the problem?



Theme: What was the lesson learned or the main topic of the story?
